Presentation Outline

A. Introduction: (Instructor #1) 10 mins:

1. Thank the staff and class
2. Introduce instructors and organization affiliation.
3. Explain Objective – why are you there?
4. Discuss Protective Riding Gear – What, Why and How it protect.
(stay way from the helmet issue!)
5. Introduce and Show Video (Instructor #1 can hide bike)

B. Instructor #2

1. Discuss video
 - a. Differences in Oregon – eye protection, foot pegs
 - b. being invisible to other drivers – being cut off
 - c. following distance (2 second – expand)
 - d. Jumping on a bike with out training and endorsement
2. Give a brief history of motorcycling
3. Discuss environmental and economic benefits of riding a motorcycle
4. Promote Team Oregon class if interested in learning to ride – under 21 – it's the Law!
Give contact 1-800-545-9944. (don't let this topic expand – defer to after class discussion)
5. Explain how motorists share the road with motorcyclists and motorcyclists are vulnerable.
6. Briefly discuss Good Samaritan Law and crash scenarios – how to best assist a downed motorcyclist (don't remove the helmet!) Call for help, stop traffic and assure motorcyclist help is on the way.

C. Outdoor Demonstration

1. Have class find the hidden motorcycle. Discuss size and invisibility.
2. Have Instructor #1 make passes. Discuss difficulty in determining speed and distance. (discuss sport and cruiser differences in sound and appearance).
3. Present accident scenarios – discussion on prevention.

Closing: Discuss education affecting fatality rates.
Discuss not using Alcohol, Drugs and other Impairments when driving or riding.
Ask if there are any questions.
Ask the students and teacher to complete the evaluation sheet.
